INOVA LOUDOUN HOSPITAL SIGNS LEASE FOR LOVETTSVILLE FACILITY

Leesburg, VA – Inova Loudoun Hospital has signed a five-year lease to occupy the former Lovettsville Post Office building located at 2 Broad Way.

"We have worked closely with Mayor Walker to identify a suitable location in Lovettsville to establish a primary care facility," observed Randy Kelley, CEO of Inova Loudoun Hospital. "We are pleased, after five years, to have closed on a lease at the old post office and look forward to getting underway with the renovation and opening of the center."

The Inova Medical Office – Lovettsville is anticipated to open September 1, offering primary care medical services in the evenings and on weekends. Inova will begin renovation immediately on the facility, building out four examination rooms. As with the Dulles South and Purcellville centers, hours will be adjusted accordingly based upon utilization.

"Inova has honored their commitment to the residents of Lovettsville. It's been a long process but, working together to identify not only the services needed but a suitable location, we are happy to announce that medical services are coming to Lovettsville," commented Mayor Elaine Walker, Town of Lovettsville.

The County's Comprehensive Plan for healthcare encourages the development of higher level, sophisticated medical services and tertiary care so Loudoun residents do not need to leave the County to access that type of care. In addition, the Comprehensive Plan sets a goal of 20-minutes drive time to emergency care for all County residents and calls for the wide dispersal of healthcare locations to ensure availability of those services in the event of disaster.

Inova Loudoun Hospital, serving Loudoun County for nearly 100 years, is part of Inova Health System, a not-for-profit healthcare system based in Northern Virginia that consists of hospitals and other health services, including emergency- and urgent-care centers, home care, nursing homes, mental health and blood donor services, and wellness classes. Governed by a voluntary board of community members, Inova's mission is to improve the health of the diverse community it serves through excellence in patient care, education and research. Inova provides a healthy environment for its patients, families, visitors, staff and physicians by prohibiting tobacco use on its campuses.
