A. East Broad Way Streetscapes Project Update

B. Fats, Oils, and Grease Program for the Sanitary Sewer System

Staff gave an update on the Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG) program requirements and the results of recent inspections of Food Services Establishments in Town. Many of the establishments are not in compliance with the Town's FOG Ordinance. The cost for installing grease traps is \$500-\$1,000. Staff will prepare recommendations for a FOG Pretreatment Systems incentive program for the Council's review.
