There were no discussion items on the agenda.

Information Items

Manager Markel presented the July 2009 – June 2010 Town Calendar as approved by the Town Council (Attachment III: Town Calendar).

Comments from Mayor and the Commissioners

Chairman Zachritz called for comments from the Commissioners.

Chairman Zachritz stated that he had sent the grocery store packet to a corporate manager at Trader Joe's and is waiting for a response. He asked Administrator McGregor for the status of the proposed Sign Ordinance. Administrator McGregor stated that Attorney Whiting is reviewing the Ordinance.

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Manager Markel noted that Attorney Whiting has been performing a number of time sensitive reviews on engineering issues, including the I&I and Germanna Drive proposals.

Chairman Zachritz stated that all lots in New Town Meadows have been sold and the roads should be ready for VDOT acceptance in the near future.

Chairman Zachritz asked that copies of the commercial proffers from Elm Street Development for Lovettsville Town Center be distributed to the Commissioners in order to expedite review when it comes to the Commission.

Commissioner Burden requested that the Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee schedule be emailed to the members the Friday before a scheduled meeting. Administrator McGregor stated that the schedule will be better established after the next CPAC meeting. It was agreed that the meetings will be posted to the Town Hall website calendar once the schedule is established.

Commissioner Gray asked for the status of the bike path and Manager Markel reported that they are still performing the survey work for the path.

Commissioner Bauer asked about the status of the Streetscape Plan and Manager Markel stated that it is moving forward as the Town works with VDOT and PRH+A. It will then go forward to the Town Council. He noted that the Town may have to work with VDOT to arrange a number of exceptions citing the narrow streets and utility poles encroaching on the right of way.

Commissioner Bushway asked if the Town had received any updates from the commercial developer at Lovettsville Town Center. Manager Markel reported that the agent has been using the packet developed by the Town since February to solicit renters and have had their own marketing literature for years.

Commissioner Fischer stated that while she is aware that there is contentiousness at Lovettsville Town Center she hopes that the existing residents will reach out to the new residents and make them feel welcome. Manager Markel reported that 15 homes are under contract at the development and that two of those will have detached garages and full front porches.

Mayor Walker endorsed Commissioner Fischer statement and thanked her for making it. She then reported the following:

- She reminded those present about the Lovettsville July 3rd celebration.
- The Movie in the Park on July 10th will be Duck Soup.
- Along with Manager Markel and representatives of other Northern Virginia organizations she met with Governor Kaine about the PATH project.

Commissioner Bushway asked what time the streets will be closed for the July 3rd parade and Manager Markel said they would be closed around 5:30 PM and that the best place to park will be in Lovettsville Park.

Administrator McGregor reported that he is in the process of enforcing swimming pool regulations and has identified at least two pools in Town that do not have permits. He noted that swimming pools of a certain size must have both Town and County permits.

Commission Chair Zachritz called for comments from the public. There were none at this time.

LVZA 2009-0005 Wireless Communications Equipment

(Zoning Ordinance Amendment)

PURPOSE: To amend the Zoning Ordinance to allow the wireless communications equipment on all land throughout the Town with a conditional use permit.

BACKGROUND: On April 23, 2009 the Town Council authorized a zoning ordinance amendment by the Town to amend the Zoning Ordinance in order to allow wireless communications equipment use on all land throughout the Town with a conditional use permit to assure that there would be no adverse impact by its installation.

A national wireless communications provider approached the Town about the possibility of installing wireless communications antennas and related equipment on the Town's elevated water storage tank. The Town ordinance does not permit such use, although it has in the past. The 1987 ordinance permitted antennas in residential and commercial zoning districts. The 1992 ordinance permitted communications uses in the C-1 district with a conditional use permit. A number of antennas have been approved for installation in the past on the Town water tower under conditional use permits.

On June 6 the Planning Commission authorized a public hearing for July 1 on this item.

DISCUSSION: Wireless communications equipment is a necessary public utility (provided by private companies licensed for operating such service) for public use. The Town should help provide such service where there is a need by people in the Town and surrounding area. Various companies provide such service and the public expects they can partake of such services from any company they choose. Therefore, the Town ordinance needs to be amended if the Town wishes to accommodate wireless communications providers. In order to assure that such facilities are designed and maintained in a satisfactory manner, the use would need to be allowed only under a conditional use permit. The Council requested that the use be available on any property under any zoning district in the Town in case it may be appropriate on other sites than the Town water tower. A definition of wireless communications equipment needs to be included in the ordinance if the use is added to the ordinance.

The following should be considered when evaluating the conditions applicable to wireless communications equipment use:

- 1. Dimensions of antenna.
- 2. Visual impact of antenna.
- 3. Specifications for ancillary cabinets or similar equipment, including materials.
- 4. Height of antenna from the ground.
- 5. Location of all equipment, including if it is co-located on existing structure.
- 6. Screening of equipment on the ground.
- 7. Location of connecting wires/cables (underground or over ground).
- 8. Material and color of all equipment, including separate tower if applicable
- 9. Access details.
- 10. Details of maintenance and repair schedule and responsibility.
- 11. Lighting and impact on adjacent and nearby property.
- 12. Backup power and alarm system to determine if sound is an issue.
- 13. Security (fences or other).
- 14. Any adverse visual impact or adverse impact on other utilities or equipment.

15. Contract details with property owner.

RECOMMENDATION: The Town is advised that allowing wireless communications equipment use under a conditional use permit will enhance the communications options for residents, businesses and workers in the Town. Therefore, the Zoning Ordinance should be amended as follows:

- **ADD:** Sec. 3-2 Residential District CR-1 (c) Conditionally Permitted Uses (xxiii) Wireless Communications Equipment.
 - Sec. 3-3 Residential District R-1 (c) Conditionally Permitted Uses (xi) Wireless Communications Equipment.
 - Sec. 3-4 Residential District R-2 (c) Conditionally Permitted Uses (ix) Wireless Communications Equipment.
 - Sec. 3-5 Residential District R-3 (c) Conditionally Permitted Uses (viii) Wireless Communications Equipment.
 - Sec. 3-6 Retirement Community R-C (r) Wireless communications equipment is permitted under a conditional use permit.
 - Sec. 3-7 Town Center Planned Development District T-C (j) Conditionally Permitted Uses (iv) Wireless communications equipment.
 - Sec. 3-8 Planned Infill District (g) Conditionally Permitted Uses (iv) Wireless communications equipment.
 - Sec. 3-12 Community Commercial District C-1 (c) Conditionally Permitted Uses (ix) Wireless communications equipment.
 - Sec. 3-13 Mixed Use Business District C-2 (c) Conditionally Permitted Uses (vii) Wireless communications equipment.
 - Sec. 3-14 Light Industrial District I-1 (g) Conditionally Permitted Uses (viii) Wireless communications equipment.
- **ADD:** Sec. 13-2 Definition of Certain Terms [Insert in alphabetical order]

"WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT: Sending and receiving antennas attached to a tower or similar structure, such as a steeple or silo, and a prefabricated or modular structure of cabinets containing electronic hardware. For purposes of this ordinance, amateur radio transmission equipment is not classified as wireless communications equipment."
