Minutes of Public Hearing and Regular Meeting October 17, 2012

Call to Order/Welcome

Chairwoman Mari Bushway called the Public Hearing of Lovettsville Planning Commission to order at 7:30 PM on Wednesday, October 17, 2012 at the Lovettsville Town Hall, 6 East Pennsylvania Avenue, Lovettsville, Virginia.

Explanation of Procedures and Opening of Public Hearing

Chairwoman Bushway read the Notice of Public Hearing for LVCU 2012-0004: Sprint Wireless Communications Equipment as it appeared in the *Purcellville Gazette* (Attachment 1).

Presentation

Zoning Administrator Hynes presented this item. The Planning Commission is being asked to consider a request by Sprint for approval of a new Conditional Use Permit to Section 3-3 (c)(xi) of the Lovettsville Zoning Ordinance, to allow for the installation of wireless communications equipment as a conditionally permitted use. The equipment will be installed on the Town's elevated water tank, located at 14A Quarter Branch Road. Sprint would like to replace the existing equipment on the tank with new equipment, as well as install additional equipment. The new equipment is needed for Sprint's 4G upgrade, which will increase the download and upload speeds of data on Sprint devices and provide better in-building coverage.

Commissioner Mueller asked about the number of devices that will be on the tank after the work is completed. Zoning Administrator Hynes said Sprint will be replacing six pieces of equipment and adding three more, for a total of nine devices.

Commissioner Jones asked how long the transition will take. Zoning Administrator Hynes said she thought it would take approximately two months to install the new equipment.

Commissioner Bauer asked if they will have to repaint those areas where the mounts for the old equipment are taken down. Zoning Administrator Hynes said she would look into this.

Zoning Administrator Hynes said the Town required Sprint to order a structural analysis of the Lovettsville Water Tank to determine if the additional weight of the new equipment would harm the tank. The analysis done by the Town's independent engineering consultant showed that the tank legs and bracing are slightly overstressed; however, the overstresses are less than five percent and are within the acceptable limit for the existing structure. She then reviewed the proposed conditions for the Conditional Use Permit.

Commissioner Mueller asked if the Town will be verifying that Sprint has completed the work in accordance with the site plan. Zoning Administrator Hynes said she would check on this.

Commissioner Bauer asked if Sprint's lease cost will increase due to the increased use of space. Zoning Administrator Hynes said that is a part of the lease negotiation process and is separate from the Conditional Use Permit.

Commissioner Summitt asked if the engineer provided a maximum threshold for all equipment on the tank. Zoning Administrator Hynes said she would check on this.

Public Comment

No members of the public were present. Chairwoman Bushway declared the Public Hearing closed at 7:51 PM.

Chairwoman Bushway called the Regular Meeting of the Lovettsville Planning Commission to order at 7:51 PM.
